



# NSATASOG – FIELD PROTOCOL

PLEASE READ PRIOR TO ATTENDING ANY EVENTS

## **Rule 1. Be on time and Report In!**

Make sure to be ready and on the field before starting time – At some Operations, we may not allow you to play if you are late. As soon as you get to the AO, report in at the Military Police station with your weapons and one empty magazine for each weapon. Provide the MP with name & team information. The MP will chrono your weapon at the MP station at that time. You may also ask the MP any questions you may have before we fall in for briefing.

## **Rule 2. Learn the rules and follow them!**

Everybody who plays shall know the rules and obey them. If there are any unclear matters, ask the Operation organizers. The rules are made to make the game safe and fun. At some Operations, some special rules may affect the standard rules, In such cases these special rules are explained before the Operation begins. We have all of our rules posted on our site and at our Operations as well as explain them prior to the Operation beginning. So there is no excuses for not knowing the rules.

## **Rule 3. Accept the team:**

The Operation organizers will divide the teams up for the Operations. Teams are different for almost every scenario, so just play with who and what you are assigned. Some Operations may require us to divide your Team up to offset experienced players, people with upgraded weapons or other reasons. You are welcome to request to be assigned to a specific team, but if we can not arrange it please don't complain, you don't have to play!

## **Rule 4. Be prepared:**

Make sure that you are ready before the Operation is about to start. Make sure your batteries are charged and everything you need is ready to go! Check the Operation details for a packing list (ie. Food, water, etc) as well as Operation information.

## **Rule 5. Responsibility for gear and Person:**

The player is responsible for anything the he or she does and uses. If a player brakes, damages while borrowing equipment, that player is responsible. Accidents do happen, but be careful, apologize if you are responsible for an accident and also pay for the damaged gear.

## **Rule 6. Missing equipment:**

Report your missing equipment to Operation Staff. Include markings and description of the item(s) (If available). If you find ANY equipment on the field, turn it over to Operation staff ASAP and please let them know where you found it. Equipment that has been found, and nobody claims ownership of may be sold after 1 month and the money goes to the Team which is hosting the Operation.

## **Rule 7. Sportsmanship and Responsibility:**

Display good sportsmanship! Being a good sportsman includes knowing and following all of the rules and Respecting everyone on the field (regardless of their which Team they are on or their Rank)! Play fair & call your outs, follow field protocol and clean up after yourself.
